# Butterfly Chandelier

## MATERIALS LIST

- 3 Sizes of Sewing Hoops
- Scrapbook or Digital Paper
- Hot Glue Gun & Sticks
- Clear String

## STEP 1



Cut out 64 butterflies using your cutting machine.

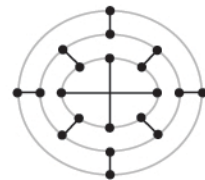
- \* You will have 16 strands with butterflies per strand.
- \*\* You can add or subtract butterflies depending on the size of your chandelier.
- \*\*\* Cut on pre-printed scrapbook paper or print out digital papers to cut on. The one's used here are from the digital BACK TO BASICS line.



## STEP 2

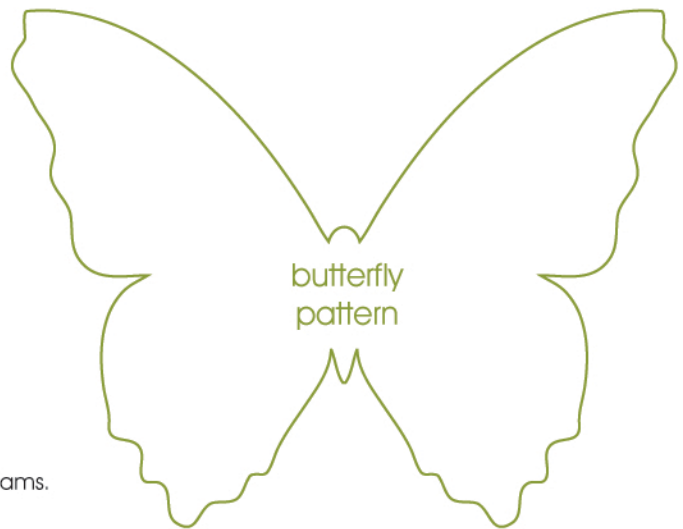


Use 3 sizes of sewing hoops and paint white.



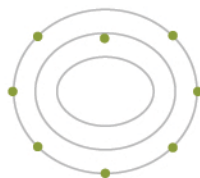
Tie together string at the points shown in diagram.

You will need 10 pieces of clear string (string size will depend on the distance between hoops).

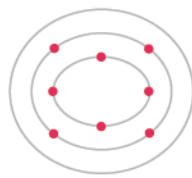


## STEP 3

Cut 8 (eight) 18 inch strands and 8 (eight) 21 inch strands.  
Place one end of the strand at the points shown in diagrams.

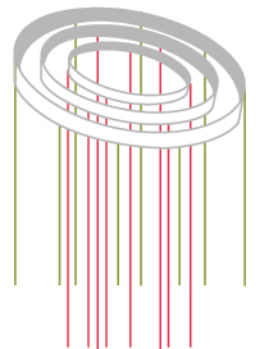


18 inch strands

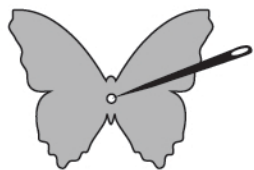


21 inch strands

Your final will look like this. →

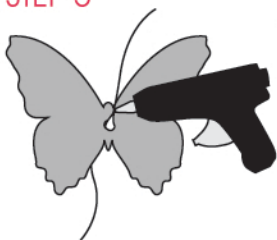


## STEP 4

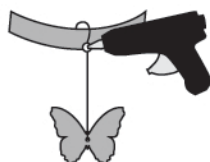


Attach butterflies to each strand.  
Space out 4 butterflies to a strand.  
Simply poke a hole using a pin in the middle of each butterfly.  
String the butterfly and space the 4 butterflies evenly apart.

## STEP 5



Dab a small amount of hot glue on the hole and butterfly.  
You can also dab hot glue on each of the knots that attach the string to the hoops to secure.



## STEP 6

Attach to a light fixture.
